Fire Fighting

General Information:

The Arkansas Gas Association's fire training exercise date is: **April 25 or April 26, 2012**; the course will be held at the SourceGas Arkansas Fire Training Facility Ozark, AR. Classroom instruction and hands on training is the focus of this exercise. All students participate in actual fire fighting techniques. Register early for this highly recommended seminar, because classes are limited to 20 students each.

Instructors: Vinny Vickers & David Smith, *Center Point Energy*-Allen Niblett, *Arkansas Oklahoma Gas Corp.* and are ANSUL trained, will be the primary instructors. Five additional instructors will be available so every student will benefit from maximum training.

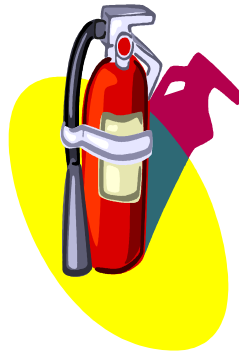
Class Length: Each six hour training session consists of two hours of classroom instruction, and four hours of actual fire fighting techniques.

Class Size: Each class is limited to 20 students, on a first-registered basis.

Lunch: Lunch will be provided and is included in the registration fee. Soft drinks will be provided for breaks.

Certificate: Students will receive a certificate upon successful completion of this class.



What to Bring:

Each two students from the same company should bring: 1 - 30 lb. & 1 - 20 lb. ANSUL type BC extinguisher or 2 -30 lb. extinguishers. If only one student attends from a company, two extinguishers are still needed.

This is a Must:

- Hardhats, safety glasses and a pair of cotton gloves are required.
 - Students must wear cotton or flame retardant clothing while participating in the fire training. Shirts must be long sleeved.
- *No nylon clothing will be allowed* —

Release Forms:

Students are required to sign a release form. The release forms will be provided at the training.

Classroom Instruction

Beginning at 9:00 a.m., a detailed lecture and demonstration of the proper use of various fire extinguishers, safety procedures, and proper maintenance and inspection of extinguishers in accordance with NFPA-10.

Hands on Session

After lunch, students will receive hands on training to learn how to safely extinguish the following types of fires:

- High-pressure natural gas impinging jet with baffle fire
- High-pressure natural gas flange fire
- Above ground flammable liquid fire
- Tri-level flammable liquid fire
- Bell hole natural gas fire
- Flammable liquid leakage fire
- Flammable liquid shop fire
- Junk pile natural gas fire
- Flammable liquid spill fire
- On ground flammable liquid fire
- Below ground flammable liquid fire

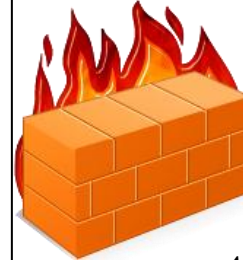

**Directions to the SourceGas Arkansas

Take I-40 to Ozark, AR-Exit 37. If you are traveling west, you will turn right off of the exit, going north.

If you are traveling East on I-40, you will turn left off the exit, going North back over the interstate.
