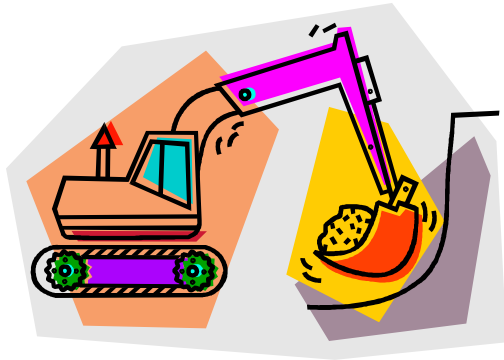

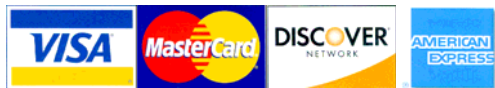

In March 1990, the Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) published stringent safety standards for trench and excavation workers.
